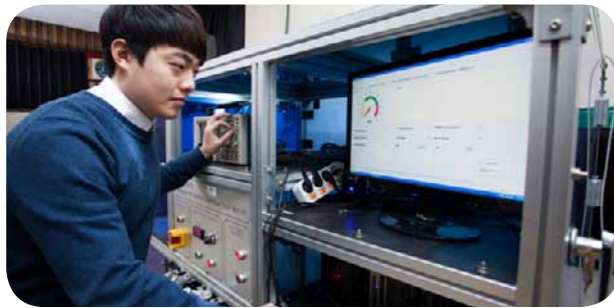

Asia Exchange

Various International Exchange Programs at Dong-A University Expanding Your Horizons to the World

Since 2008, Dong-A University has been selected as a commissioned educational institute for Korean government sponsored winners of international scholarships, which are administered by NIIED (National Institute for International Education) of MEST (Ministry of Education and Science Technology). Dong-A University, which has truly proven to be a global university, puts its utmost effort into education support and operation of customized education programs, including international student support and Korean language programs for beginners to advanced speakers.



Exchange Students

The Dong-A University students may study one term to maximum of one year at a sister university. The tuition for the sister university is covered by the tuition of Dong-A University. As a result, numerous students have the opportunity to study at sister universities around the world.

Dual Degree Program

The Dual Degree Program is opened to all students motivated to undertake a degree program at Dong-A University and another at a sister university in the dual degree program agreement. All Dual Degree Program students receive both bachelor's degrees from the two universities.

International Language Training Program

This program provides students with the opportunity to study a foreign language during a break or a term at a sister university. Also, these students have the opportunity to experience a foreign culture.

International Internships

Students participating in the International Internship program may work as an intern at a foreign company or university. This program was established to offer students the opportunity to gain practical experience in order to improve their global competitiveness.

Term Dispatch Program

The Term Dispatch Program was established to provide students with more opportunities to study abroad. Students undertake a language program or a major program at a sister university for a term. Students have the same status as exchange students and undergo the same training, except that the exchange students are exempt from the tuition.

Overseas Seasonal Terms

Students may take major or regional research courses as language courses at UC-Berkeley of the USA, Kyushu University of Japan, and Dong Hua University of China during the summer seasonal term.

Overseas Volunteering

Students participate in various local volunteer activities during summer or winter break in Europe and China's Yanbian. Through this voluntary service, students experience a different culture, widen their human understanding, and learn mutual respect. As a result, it is an excellent opportunity for them to observe and experience globalization at first hand.

DAU-SGU Exchange Student Program

Dong-A University and Sapporo Gakuin University offer a one-week exchange student program. Through this program, students gain an appreciation of Korean and Japanese cultures, an appreciation which will strengthen the relationship between the two nations.

Korean Summer Session

The Korean Summer Session is a short-term program offered for 2 to 3 weeks, which offers the opportunity to learn the Korean language and culture to the students of sister universities. There are elementary Korean classes and seminars on the Korean economy / social studies / cultural studies. Foreign students also meet Dong-A University students via the buddy system.

••• International Center

The International Center with 2 underground floors and 12 floors above began its construction in September of 2009 and was completed 2 years and 9 months later. It contains the DAU Hall (a multi-purpose hall which can host international seminars and performances), the Global Zone, a state-of-the-art library, and accommodations, all of which makes it the place for international academic research and international exchange. It also plays an important role as the place for performance globalization.

••• Global Zone

The Global Zone is a place conducive to the exchange of languages and cultures, where Korean and international students can meet. In order to improve their language skills, students can watch foreign TV channels and participate in 1:1 conversations with foreign language teachers. The facility is stocked with regular publications in English, Japanese, and Chinese. The Global Zone prepares new language training and cultural experience programs each month, enabling students to improve their foreign language skills and learning how to become better global citizens.

••• Library

Dong-A University has large scale libraries in Seunghak, Bumin, and Gudeok Campuses and affiliate Legal Studies and Medical Studies Library Annexes. These facilities have over 4,800 seats, over 1 million books, and over 11,400 serial publications. In particular, the International Center has a 6-story state-of-the-art library (floors 5-10). Recently, these libraries acquired various e-books and research databases, becoming the repository of the latest knowledge.

••• Comprehensive Lecture Building

The Comprehensive Lecture Building, taking up 40,311m² in space and with 18 floors in total (3 underground floors and 15 floors above), located in the Bumin Campus, boasts a beautiful exterior and has received the Silver Prize in the 4th Beautiful Architecture Contest, administered by the city of Busan. This building has state-of-the-art lecture halls, laboratories, a library, administration offices, research rooms, a multi-purpose hall, and an exhibition hall.

••• Museum

The Dong-A University Museum has been remodeled while maintaining the traditional elements of the provisional capital government building as designated by Modern Cultural Property. It belongs to the category of a top-tier university museum, holding approximately 30,000 items, including 2 National Treasures, 11 Treasures, 2 Registered Cultural Properties, and 25 City of Busan's Select Cultural Properties. It provides data for academic research, as well as being open to the general public and conducting history experience programs.

••• Remote Real-Time Video Lecture Hall

Dong-A University's STUDIO video lecture system is the world's first 3D technology remote real-time video lecture hall. It has a video lecture system that is a level higher than others available at American, Canadian, and Korean universities. Students listening and viewing the lecture from another campus can actively participate by asking the lecturer questions.

••• Startup Business Center

Constructed by the university to secure a training facility for the development of green technology and new energy businesses, the Dong-A University Startup Business Center is Busan's first business startup facility, where students can research and study how to start a business and produce prototypes. It also has a one-stop startup business support programming capabilities. The Startup Business Center, with 1 underground floor and 4 floors above, contains 5 factory-type training rooms, 23 regular training rooms, an administration and meeting room, a product show room, and relaxation rooms. Its facilities include various instruments that enable one-stop production, such as a 10-ton mega crane, an MCT, and turning center. The center is expected to give more systematic and effective support to business startups

••• Dong-A University Medical Center

The Dong-A Medical Center, established along with the Department of Medical Studies in March 1990, upholds as its motto: trust, service, and charity. It has served the local community through accurate diagnoses and effective treatment with its state-of-the-art facility and medical equipment. In cooperation with the College of Medical Sciences to provide better health welfare and eradicate diseases posing a threat to the nation, the center has produced cutting-edge clinical medical research, has turned out excellent medical professionals, has delivered the latest medical technology and information to the local medical community, and has been playing a central role as an educational hospital.

••• Informational Processing Education Center & Internet Cafe

Dong-A University offers campus-wide wifi, and computers with high-speed internet connection are available throughout the campuses, enabling students to use the Internet. Also, the computers have various software programs, including MS Office, Photoshop, Illustrator, Auto CAD, statistics package programs, and website construction programs, which support the training of students, improving their IT capabilities

••• Hallim Dormitory

The Hallim Life Center, a cozy and comfortable dormitory available to everyone at Dong-A, presents foreign students an opportunity to familiarize themselves with Busan and also offers room and board to students who have a long commute or who are undergoing financial hardship. After the Hallim Life Center was built, Seunghak Hall, which boasts a massive facility (currently in construction), the Gudeok Hall in October of 2010 and Bumin Hall in August of 2012 were established, enabling even more members of Dong-A to enjoy a pleasant and comfortable university life.
